Rebuys are \$20 each for 1000 chips. You must have 4000 chips or less in order to make a rebuy. This means that you may make four rebuys if at 1000 or less. If you go all-in and lose, leaving you with no chips, you may make up to five rebuys. You may start the tournament with up to three rebuys before the first hand is dealt. In order to make the add-on at the break you must have at least one chip, otherwise you must first make at least one rebuy. The add-on is \$50 for 10,000 chips.

The *Fourth Street Rule* applies; it states that when an open pair is showing on fourth street (second upcard), any player has the option of betting either the lower or upper limit. Once the upper limit has been bet on that round, nobody may bet the lower limit. On fifth street, only the upper limit may be bet, regardless of whether a pair is showing.



Prize money will be awarded to the Top 3 spots or 15% of the field...whichever is greater.

An optional \$10 dealer appreciation add-on for 1000 chips will be available for all players and alternates.
